Adoption fee negotiations must be handled by a W2W Director. Please ask one of us to help your potential adopter if they have questions concerning adoption fees.

Volunteers must not pay or offer to pay adoption fees.

Adoption fees are normally \$75.00 which includes spay /neuter, rabies vaccination, all shots, flea & worm treatments and micro-chipping.

The fee for additional cats may be negotiable in some cases.

There may be kittens and cats that require a special adoption fee greater than or less than the standard fee for a variety of reasons.

Special breeds or thoroughbred cats. (rare, but it does happen!)

Special conditions i.e. cats that are bonded & must be adopted together.

Cats that have been declawed.

Military / First Responder Discounts (only during specific dates)

Other conditions not listed.

Volunteers are expected to "police" the kennels to make sure unattended children are asked to 'look but don't touch' the cats unless a parent is present.

Make sure hand sanitizer is applied before clients pet the cats. One application will be enough for all cats.

Children are not allowed inside the kennel area.

Kittens are not handled, held, etc. unless permission is obtained from a director. Serious adopters are normally okay for kitten handling.

Volunteers may be asked to accompany adopters to a 'get acquainted area' to insure proper handling procedures are followed.

Volunteers are expected to perform other duties as assigned.

Student community service hours will be logged before leaving for the day.
